- Weekly Evening Meetings are held at ⁽¹⁾St. Andrew's United Church Hall in Cochrane, from 6:30 to 9:00 pm, two or three Tuesdays monthly, and a Schedule is issued at the start of our painting year
 - Meetings can be for Business, Open Painting, or Instructional Purposes
- Weekend Instructional Sessions and Open Studio Painting are held at the ⁽¹⁾Beaupre Community Hall, in a beautiful setting west of Cochrane. Hours for all weekend sessions are: 9:30 am to 4:30 pm, Saturday and Sunday. Depending on availability of the hall, Open Painting on a Monday follows a weekend session.
