Information:

- The annual fee is \$150.00.

- Our painting year runs from the beginning of September to the end of May. Additional Summer activities may be organized.
- Additional fees will be required for Instructional Workshops.
- Weekly evening meetings are held at St. Andrew's United Church Hall in Cochrane, from 6:00 to 8:30 pm, two or three Tuesdays monthly. In addition, some afternoon meetings are scheduled in the fall. A schedule is issued at the start of the painting year.
 - Meetings can be for business, open painting, or instructional purposes
- Weekend instructional sessions and open studio painting are held at the Beaupre Community Hall, in a beautiful setting west of Cochrane. Hours for all weekend sessions are: 9:30 am to 4:30 pm, Saturday and Sunday. Depending on availability of the hall, Open Painting on a Monday follows a weekend session.
